

Commencing in the 2019-20 season all AAA teams, clubs and associations within the Ontario Hockey Federation (OHF) are to use Electronic AAA Hockey Waivers rather than the printed two-part Waiver used in previous years.

All AAA Waiver emails must be sent to the parent or guardian of the player and copied to the OMHA and OHF using the submission process below. Once completed the information will automatically be emailed to the email address provided for the player with a copy to the issuing Centre/Zone, the OMHA and the OHF. No further action will be required on your part to complete the issuing of the Waiver. OMHA AAA Centres/Zones must use this submission method to issue Waivers. Waivers may not be submitted by an OMHA AAA Centre/Zone using an individual email account unless otherwise directed by the OMHA.

In order to be eligible for a AAA Waiver, a player must register for AAA try outs, attend AAA try outs in their appropriate age division and not have signed, or been offered a card to sign, with that club/association/zone team. For an adjacent AAA club/association/zone team to permit a non-resident player to try out the player must provide a copy of the Electronic AAA Waiver either printed or emailed. Players not signed or offered a card in accordance with OHF Regulation E32 are entitled to apply for a AAA Waiver, and no request for the Waiver shall be unduly denied or delayed. In the Lake Ontario Region (LOR) the card must be offered in accordance with OHF Regulation E59.

The President or Delegate of each Centre/Zone team must provide the AAA Waivers. The President does however have the freedom to authorize another executive member(s) to provide the AAA Waivers for all AAA teams within the Centre/Zone or alternatively the Head Coach or Manager of the team at each Division to provide the AAA Waivers.

The Electronic AAA Waiver must be emailed, through the OMHA Portal, to the parent by the President, Delegate or other authorized individual, the day immediately following the player being released and within the following specified timeframes:

- No later than 12:00 PM on the following day if the tryout takes place Sunday to Thursday.
- No later than 9:00 AM on the following day if the tryout takes place on Friday or Saturday.
