Penalty Codes and Electronic Game Sheets

This year many of the Hockey Canada codes have changed and the way information is put into the iPad has changed. This bulletin will attempt to deal with those changes. For now, the Rec division still uses paper game sheets so this will not apply.

Some codes need to be explained

DAB-MSD Disrespectful and Abusive Behavior - Misconduct (10 Minutes) Rule 11.2(d)

- This code is similar to the M20 we used to issue. When a player is behaving like a “donkey” and you want to issue a 10-minute misconduct, use this code. This code is used when a player shows disrespect to an official.

DAB-GM Disrespectful and Abusive Behavior - Game Misconduct (10 Minutes) Rule 11.2(e)

- This code is similar to the GM20/GM21 we used to issue. When you want to suspend a player/coach for disrespectful behaviour, use this code.

DAB-GRM Disrespectful and Abusive Behavior - Gross Misconduct (10 Minutes) Rule 11.2(f)

- Use this code when someone is making a travesty of the game or using threatening language or gestures.

USC-MIN Unsportsmanlike Conduct – Minor Rule 11.1(a)

- This code is 2 minute “unsportsmanlike” code. Similar to what we have used in the past

USC-MSD Unsportsmanlike Conduct - Misconduct (10 Minutes)

- This code is similar to the M20 we used to issue to issue for when a player does dumb things (e.g. shooting the puck after the whistle, spraying snow etc.). This code is used when a player commits a poor sportsmanlike act.

USC-GM Unsportsmanlike Conduct - Game Misconduct (10 Minutes)

- This is a suspendable code used when coaches or players continue to misbehave. This code may only be used if you have issued a USC-MIN or USC-MSD first.

Listed above is a sample iPad game sheet with errors that I have seen throughout the year. When examining your game sheet please make sure to focus on these areas.

●	The game score does not match the actual score. This was a glitch that happened in a couple of game sheets and should be fixed but please make sure you check the final score.
●	A CFB-MAJ was called but there is no corresponding CFB-GM. Any major penalty needs to have two entries – one for the infraction and one for the GM (the CFB-MIN needs to have a CFB-GM as well). Note: the game sheet does not require that the GM code be attached to the penalty – it should be automatic but it isn't! Please make sure you have the GM code attached.
●	A USC-GM was called without having a USC-MIN or USC-MSJ called first. While you typically do not need to “go up the ladder” the USC-GM code requires that a USC-MIN or USC-MSJ be called first. The correct call would be DAB-GM
●	The player, #39, was issued a 5-minute GM for CFB but he did not leave the game. He continued to play even though he should have been ejected.
●	The player received a double minor for head contact after the game was over. The player left the bench, without the permission of the referee, and incurred the penalty. An additional LPB-GM would be assessed to the coach. In this incident we are assuming the player did not leave the bench for the purposes of starting a fight.
